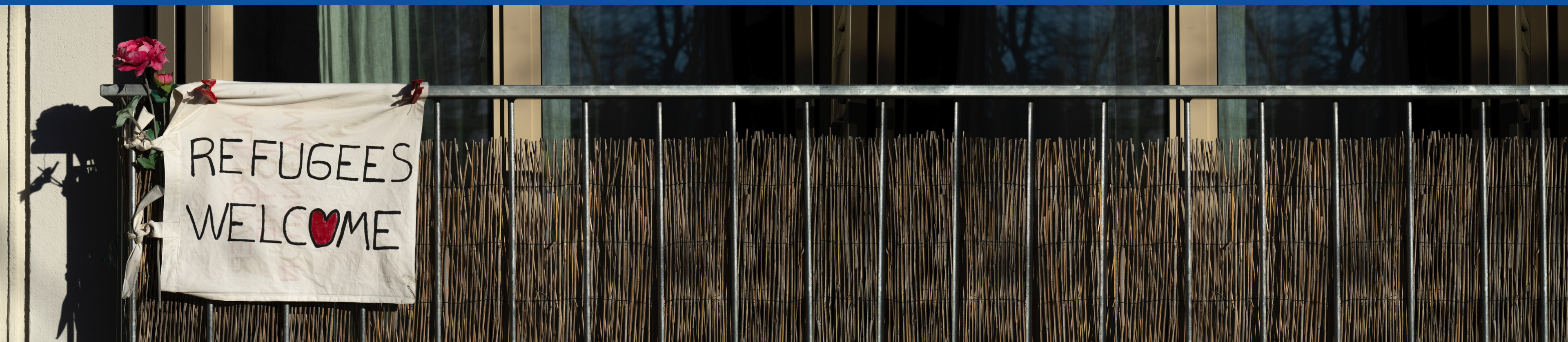
More than **2 million people** have **fled their homes and sought refuge in Europe** since 2015 due to war, oppression, climate change, socioeconomic and political factors.

Hello, we're Indigo Volunteers

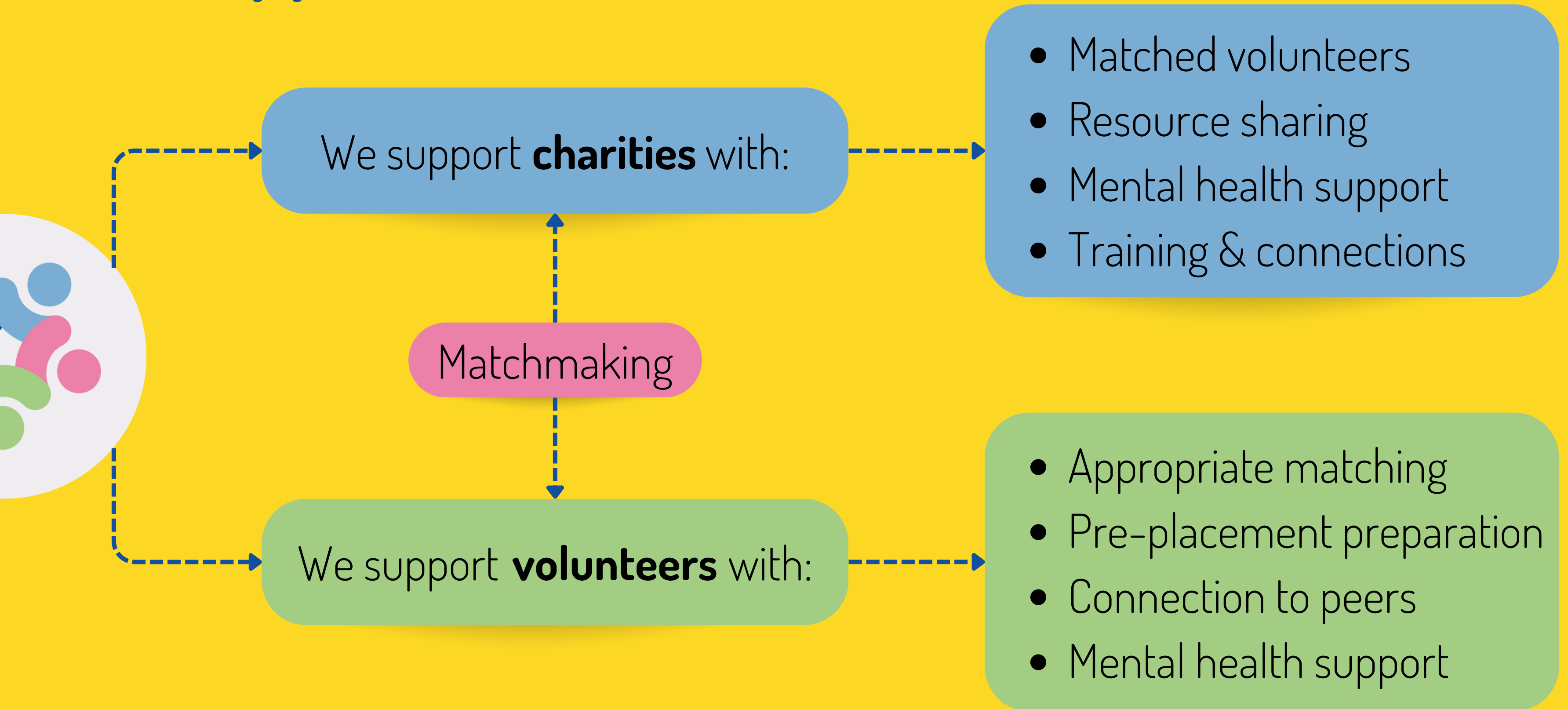
Founded in 2012, we're a small non-political UK charity with a global team who are passionate about responsible volunteering and supporting refugees.

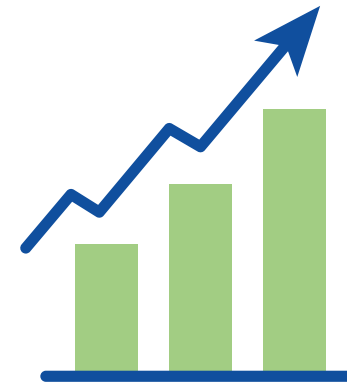
