# Indigo's Covid-19 response


At the beginning of the year most of our partners were suddenly forced to adapt, reduce or stop their operations in reaction to the outbreak of the pandemic. We quickly responded by temporarily halting volunteer placements and instead launching an emergency programme, including:

For volunteers we facilitated remote support sessions with qualified counsellors, psychotherapists and life coaches.

**For partner organisations** we organised webinars on a range of humanitarian and organisational topics, such as safety and security, fundraising, leadership, effective self-care, and much more.

**For the safety of the local and refugee communities** we initiated a rigorous risk management programme, encouraging our partners to consider and mitigate all potential dangers regarding their operations.

**For our online audience** we launched an Instagram live series 'Let's Talk Grassroots' to keep people engaged and connected with the field. Our guests included Hassan Akkad, Camilla Thurlow, Josie Naughton and many more. **Watch here.**
